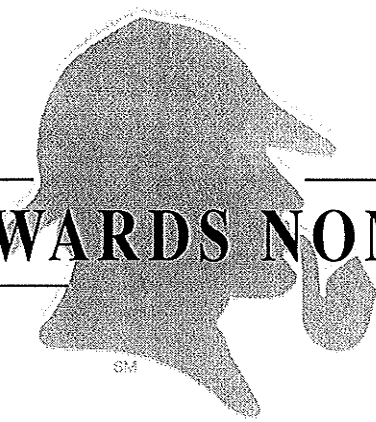

TOP COP Award Categories

The awards are intended to honor law enforcement professionals in each participating city/county along with individuals, corporations and organizations that have made a commitment to a safer Hampton Roads community. These persons, organizations and corporations should be considered leaders and role models for both their peers and their community. You may submit as many nominations as you desire. Nominations are accepted and presented annually in the following categories:

Hampton Roads Top Cop Award

Nominees will be considered based on exemplary leadership skills and/or personal achievements that have impacted the Hampton Roads Community by making it safer as a result of their efforts between January 1, 2010 and April 1, 2011.

Law Enforcement Professional (Top Cop)

Nominees from each participating Hampton Roads community will be considered for the Top Cop award for their locale. Nominees will be considered based on exemplary leadership skills and/or personal achievements that have impacted their locale by making it safer as a result of their efforts between January 1, 2010 and April 1, 2011. The rationale for nomination should be consistent, salutary performance and dedication over the entire period, not a single action.

Corporation, Organization & Individual

Nominees will be considered based on how their supportive efforts have impacted the Hampton Roads Community by making it safer as a result of their actions between January 1, 2010 and April 1, 2011.

Lifetime Achievement Award

Nominees will be considered based on outstanding leadership skills and/or personal achievements that have, over a period of ten or more years, consistently improved the safety of the Hampton Roads Community. The actions must be in direct support of crime solving in the Hampton Roads area.

Nomination Rules:

- Nominees must reside in the Hampton Roads area and perform service in a participating city/county.
- Corporations and organizations must be located in the Hampton Roads area.
- Incomplete forms cannot be accepted.
- Nominators may submit more than one nomination.
- Forms must be received by AUGUST 19, 2011.
- Nomination form must be included with supporting documentation.
