The region's seven local Crime Line/Crime Solvers programs are supported solely through contributions from private sources. Tax dollars do not support these programs. This dinner is our major regional fundraiser. We are asking the region's businesses, organizations and citizens to contribute through sponsorship donations, as described on the attachment.
